

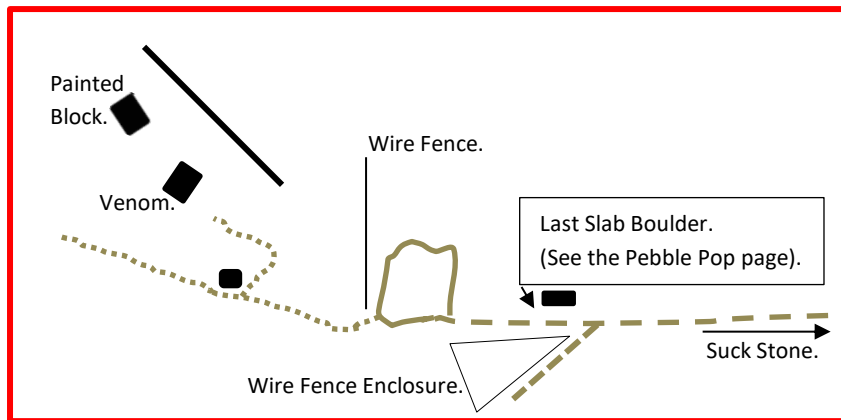
Getting there...

This sector, that has mini route potential, is best tackled as part of a long day out that includes a trip to the Staunton circuits as you will pass these en route. Having walked all the way to the Suck Stone, keep going until the track ends at what could be described as a turning circle. There is a wire fence which you can easily breach and this is the route to Block X. Having gone around the fence, drop down the steep slope trending slightly rightwards for approximately 30 metres where upon you will see a small chunk of limestone on your right. Turn right here and follow your nose downhill for another 20 metres with the quarry wall to your right. The Painted Block is further down the rocky slope. You will pass a horizontal mini roof, which might take body weight...

Venom. SDS. 7a/+. The narrow face is a superb problem. F.A. D. Cross.
